Murray's Malts

Highlands

Mackays Special Reserve 1972 (Aged 37yr) (70cl, 58,86%)

An 'old fashioned' malt rich and heavy; a reminder of what whisky tasted like 30 years ago-but it is also a remarkable marriage of spirit and wood.

Mackays hotel Exclusive 1984 (G&M) Pulteney Distillery (70cl/46%)

Vanilla, gorse flowers, apple, sweet pineapple, pears, cinnamon with milk chocolate finish.

D. Rattray Cask Collection 17 (Balblair 1990)

Raisin, sultanas and cherries. Dark chocolate, raisins and almonds. Christmas pudding anyone?!

D. Rattray Cask Collection 26 (Old Pulteney 1982)

Brazil nuts and chocolate. Marmalade. Slighly salty with a hint of smoke. Perfect balance from this Northern Star!

D. Rattray Cask collection 29 (Glenglassaugh 1976)

Creamy yet fresh. Summer fruit cake. Fantastic oak flavours. Coffee and poached peaches. Complex. Beautiful balance.

D. Rattray Cask collection 30 (Glencadam 1975)

Tropical fruit salad. Mango, guava and banana. Classic fruit medley. Intense and lasting. Simple divine!

D. Rattray Cask Collection 30 (Teaninich 1975)

Honey coated pears. Complex. Very fresh for a whisky of its age. Egg custard. Dynamic & constantly evolving. Truly impressive.

D. Rattray – 14 (Tullibardine 1990)

Rich toffee fruit, sultanas and stewed apples. Great depth of flavour with well-defined fruity backbone.



G&M Private Collection Sauternes Wood Finish (Old Pulteney 1994) (70cl, 45%)

Notes of white grape and spice with honeyed Tokaji notes and toasty barley sugars. There is a dry oak not with cereals and tropical fruits.

Speyside

D. Rattray Cask collection 14 (Longmorn 1990)

Fragrant and nutty, vanilla and marzipan. Dry and complex, very mellow a superb finish.

D. Rattray Cask Collection 19 (Linkwood 1985)

Sticky toffee pudding, rich vanilla chocolate. Very long and warming. Rich, heavyweight. A real delight to savour.

D. Rattray Cask Collection 25 (Caperdonich 1980)

Nutty and dry on the nose. Toasted citrus rind. Panacotta and cheesecake rice pudding sprinkled with cinnamon. A whisky to accompany the sweet trolley.

D. Rattray Cask Collection 31 (Strathmill 1975)

Rich and fruity. Caramelised fruit and vanilla. Complex and long. Very Special.

Islay

D. Rattray Cask Collection 15 (Bowmore 1989)

Very smoky, fresh and seaweedy, freshly cut peat. The perfect Islay balance - with punch



Single Malt Whiskies

North Highlands

Old Pulteney 12yr Old (70cl, 40%) Dry, medium bodied & smooth, faintly salty with a slight sherry note. Elegant touches of smoke & peat.

Old Pulteney 15yr (70cl, 46%)

Intense yet balanced. Bursting with rich dried fruit, ripe apples and citrus, with honey sweetness and a generous chord of creamy vanilla. Slightly chocolaty and floral in the background.

Old Pulteney 17yr old (70cl, 46%) *Polished oak, honeycomb, mint, pineapple and hazelnuts.*

Old Pulteney 18yr Old (70cl, 46%) *Cinnamon-spiced cookie dough, mature oak, a very light touch of charcoal.*

Old Pulteney 21yr Old (70cl, 46%)

Lots of gingery balanced and with a delicate mineral-salted spiciness.

Old Pulteney Isabella Fortuna WK499 11 (100cl, 46%)

Aromatic and perfumed with hints of bergamot, coconut, tropical fruits, butterscotch, toffee apples and malt.

Old Pulteney Huddart (70cl, 46%)

Wood smoke and honey with leather and apple notes, creamy vanilla and toffee in the background.

Old Pulteney 1989 Vintage (bottled 2015) (70cl, 46%)

Toasted brioche and salted butter at first. Slowly develops notes of fresh doughnuts, sea shells and a drop of candle wax. Give it a few minutes for a wisp of smoke to appear.

Wolfburn Aurora Single Malt (70cl, 46%)

Waves of sweet almonds and pecans, underlying with tones of sticky Sherry notes. This sweet treat features lingering Sherries spice on the finish.



Wolfburn Northland Single Malt (70cl, 46%)

Initially sweet with notes of fruit and fresh sea air. In the background you'll find citrus freshness and hints of cereal, and just a trace of peat smoke.

Highlands

Ardmore Traditional Unchillfiltered (70cl, 46%) Toasted oak is evident and rich and just the faintest peat has muscled its way through.

Balblair 2005 1st Release (70cl, 46%)

Oak-y vanilla, chocolate-y malt and light wisps of smoke.

Fettercairn Fior (70cl, 42%) Smoke, sherry, toffee, vanilla, and oranges merge on the nose and palate.

Glendronach 12yr Old (70cl, 43%) *Creamy vanilla, with hints of ginger.*

Glengoyne 12yr Old Cask Strength (70cl, 57.2%) Fig, peppery oak, lemon zest and bourbon biscuits.

Glenmorangie 10yr Old The Original (70cl, 40%) Vanilla and a burst of fruitiness with hints of orange & peach.

Loch Lomond 12yr Old (70cl, 46%) Creamy vanilla, with a touch of freshly baked apple turnover.

Tomatin Cù Bòcan (70cl, 46%) Lightly peated single malt matured in a compelling combination of Virgin Oak, Bourbon and Sherry casks.



Campbeltown

Glen Scotia Double Cask (70cl, 46%)

Peach flesh and green apple peels, followed by chewy vanilla fudge, a hint of salinity, then an array of oak-y spices including some char.

Springbank 10yr Old (70cl, 46%)

Notes of exotic fruits and a hint of salinity. The palate is full-bodied with a good helping of cereal sweetness.

Islands

Highland Park 12yr old (70cl, 40%)

Sweet burning heather is the trademark of this exceptional 12-year-old from Orkney.

Isle of Jura Superstition (70cl, 43%)

Heavily peated younger malt and older Jura making a great alternative for Islay fans.

Ledaig 10yr Old (70cl, 46.3%)

Quite light and well-balanced. Soft peat with a gentle smoke. Notes of barley and malt extract, with walnut and pine oil and a hint of iodine, dried fruit and nuts.

Scapa 2001 (Gordon & MacPhail) (70cl, 43%)

Light and fruity with green apples, white grapes and sweet vanilla. A subtle smokiness develops.

Talisker 10yr old (70cl, 45.8%)

A rich dried-fruit sweetness with clouds of smoke and strong barley-malt flavours.



Islay

Bowmore 12yr old (70cl, 40%)

Sweet and delicious heather honey and gentle peat smoke.

Caol Ila 12yr old (70cl, 43%)

Fresh, herbal. Rubbed peppermint leaves, stemmy, damp grass, smoky. Oily, cigar leaves, smoked ham, hickory. Lemon peels at the harbour.

Lagavulin 16yr Old (70cl, 43%)

Sweet spices, good, mature Sherry and creamy vanilla. Very thick and rich.

Laphroaig 10yr old (70cl, 40%)

Richly smoky, fully peated with a hint of salty-sweetness.

Lowlands

Auchentoshan American Oak (70cl, 40%)

Oranges and lemons, toffee chunks and milk chocolate. Wafts of grassy air and clotted cream.

Cutty Sark 18yr Old (70cl, 43%)

Well-balanced, refined. Sherried peels. Barley, hints of smoke, peat. Fruitcake. Spices.

Speyside

Aberlour A'Bunadh (70cl, 59.6%)

Sherried raisins, hints of toffee and a pleasant nuttiness.

Aultmore 12yr Old (70cl, 46%)

Fresh and vibrant with crunchy apples and pears, floral notes and gentle creaminess.



Balvenie 12yr Old Double Wood (70cl, 40%)

Sweet fruit and oloroso sherry notes, layered with honey and vanilla.

BenRiach Curiositas 10yr Old (70cl, 40%)

Sublimely medicinal, sweet grassy asphalt and heather. Hints of malmsey.

Benrinnes 15yr Old Flora and Fauna (70cl, 43%)

Slightly doughy. Toffee chip biscuits. Floral. Rounded, good sweetness. A whiff of peat.

Benromach 21yr Old (70cl, 43%)

Urbane. Gentle oiliness, herbal. Sherry flickers in and out. Big bodied, spicy toffee and caramel. More sherry, gentle sultana sweetness.

Benromach Single Cask Latitude 57 (70cl, 57%)

Special bottling to celebrate the Clipper 07-08 Round the World Yacht Race, featuring the Glasgow: Scotland With Style Clipper.

Benromach Peat Smoke (70cl, 46%)

Rum-glazed ham, with subtle wafts of lemon and thyme.

Benromach Sassicaia Wood Finish (70cl, 45%)

Fresh strawberries and Alpine herbs. A touch of chocolate. In the palate creamy and sweet with caramel and treacle, joined by another burst of summer berries.

Cragganmore 12yr Old (70cl, 40%)

Dark fruits mixed with light honey and cooked peach.

Glen Elgin 12y Old (70cl, 43%)

Cereals. Rich. Malt. Smoky espresso, honeycomb.

Glenfiddich Caoran reserve 12yr Old (70cl, 40%)

Fruity with a touch of pear, subtle pine and a hint of peatiness.



Glenfarclas 10yr Old (70cl, 40%)

Lots of sherry, juicy. Honey, touch of toffee, creamy. Malty, barley.

Glenrothes 1994 (70cl, 43%)

Lemon freshness, notes of grilled pink grapefruit, a touch of thick creamy toffee and toasted cereal notes, a little juicy fruitiness and a floral note.

Glenrothes 1995 (70cl, 43%)

Toffee apples and hints of allspice.

Glenrothes Select Reserve (70cl, 43%)

Lots of zesty rich fruit on the nose. Thick Seville marmalade, bubbling on a hot stove with notes of toasted cereals.

Macallan 1995 18yr Old Sherry Oak (70cl, 43%)

Classic spiced dried fruits and creamy vanilla with orange peel, crystallised ginger and apple wood.

Macallan Gold 1824 Series (70cl, 40%)

Lemon citrus, then orange peel and an interlacing sweetness

Macallan Sienna 1824 Series (70cl, 43%)

Raisins and dried apricots, ripe greengages, frozen currants.

Speyburn Bradan Orach (70cl, 40%)

Fruity, malty. Orchard fruits, blossom, hints of light citrus, creamy.

Strathisla 12yr Old (70cl, 40%)

Soft oak and hints of candied peel. A little floral character too, with notes of spice and Danish pastries.

Stronachie 12yr Old (70cl, 43%)

Heather honey, malt. Grassy, fruity and dry with hints of almond.



Blended Whiskies

Blended Premium Scotch Whisky

Chivas Regal 12yr Old (70cl, 40%)

A creamy, aromatic melange of vanilla custard, hints of aniseed, lemon curd and butter toffee. Wood shavings and dried banana chips develop with just a hint of cassis.

Monkey Shoulder Blended Malt Scotch Whisky (70cl, 40%)

An elegant, stylish nose of marmalade, cocoa and malt. Plenty of vanilla and a sprinkling of winter spice (nutmeg, cloves and cinnamon) alongside a mouth-watering hint of aniseed.

Blended Scotch Whisky

Johnnie Walker Black Label 12yr Old (70cl, 40%)

Winter spice and treacle, hints of white pepper and a little citrus.

Johnnie Walker Green Label 15yr Old (70cl, 43%)

Notes of mochaccino and espresso coffee, wood smoke and a fireplace, a touch of bitter chocolate and oak.

Blended whiskey

Canadian Club Whisky (70cl, 40%)

Barley sugar and aniseed, notes of cut grass and fennel, a hint of straw and a vegetal freshness.

Gentleman Jack (70cl, 40%)

Spicy nose with caramel, charred oak and a little aniseed. Liquorice-led palate with oak and cinnamon and a touch of banana.

Jack Daniel's Single Barrel (70cl, 45%)

Good body with plenty of toasty oak, there are notes of corn and lovely cereal sweetness, there is a good smoke note, a little spice and toffee.



Jack Daniel's Old No.7 (70cl / 40%)

Light with plenty of sweetness. There are hints of dry spice and oily nuts, a touch of smoke.

Jameson Irish Whiskey (70cl, 40%)

Full and floral with a smooth sweetness. Marmalade and fudge, Madeira and a little cut grass note.

Others

Barrogill Blended Highland Malt Whisky (Mey selection) (70cl, 40%)

Medium-body with a cut herbal note, hints of esters with notes of smoke and barley sweetness.

Black Bottle (70cl, 40%)

Mix of fruitiness and spice alongside the peaty Islay notes that the brand has been known for.

Bushmills Black Bush (70cl, 40%)

Barley, grape, lemon. Very fruity, milky.

Bulleit Bourbon (70cl, 45%)?

Bright with orange zest, toasted oak and vanilla.

Cameron Brig Single Grain - Cameron Brig (70cl, 40%)?

Light, subtle. Honey, spice. Caramel, mixed peels, a touch of sherry, sultanas.

CU DHUB Black Whisky (70cl / 40%)

Well-rounded and smooth. Notes of gentle peat and wafting smoke. Hints of dark nuttiness and espresso beans.

Highland Park 1990 The Dragon (70cl / 54.9%)

Light golden, colour and a sweet, smoky, citrus bouquet.

Penderyn Madeira Aur Cymru (70cl / 46%)

Classic freshness with aromas of cream toffee, rich fruit and raisins. Notes of tropical fruit, raisins and vanilla persist in the finish.

Pinwinnie Royale 1960s (75cl, 40%)

Smooth, mellow with sweet, fragrant notes.
